



Homeward Bound September 2016 BAM Charity Project

Your kit has 8 squares, two light and two dark of each of the two colors, green and teal. The kit will make two blocks.

1. Pair up the squares. There are four different pairs:

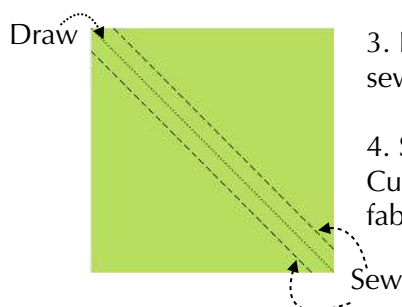
Light green with dark green

Light teal with dark teal

Light green with light teal

Dark green with dark teal

2. Draw a diagonal line on one square from each pair.



3. Please double check your seam allowances and make sure you are sewing an accurate 1/4 inch seam.

4. Sew 1/4 inch away from the diagonal on both sides of the diagonal. Cut along the diagonal. Now you have two hst squares from each pair of fabric squares for a total of 8.

We are making blocks with a shaded green arrow. The teal will make a secondary arrow once all the blocks are put together. The block you make should have a green arrow pointing up and to the right. Please pay careful attention to placement of the pieces. All the blocks that everyone makes need to be the same in order for shading to be correct in the final quilts.



5. Sew the dark green/ dark teal and the dark teal/ light teal squares together as shown.



6. Sew the light green/ dark green square to the light green/light teal square so that the light green pieces make a trapezoid or slanty rectangle shape.



7. Sew the two rectangles together so the dark green triangles make a trapezoid. The dark colors are all at the top and left of the block.
