fat quarter stack has 21 fabrics. but not really because people used some of the pieces at the retreat.

One fat quarter will make rectangles for 2 blocks. bed sized quilt is 20 blocks. so that needs 10 fat quarters.
background 20 blocks each block has:
2 (40) $13 \times 3$ rectangles, 12 across, 4 rows, 52 inches.
2 (40) $8 \times 3$ rectangles, 12 across, 4
rows, 32 inches.
$21 / 2$ yards for one bed sized quilt.
4-5 extra of each rectangle.
3 NICU size 12 blocks
6 fat quarters
background:
2 (24) $13 \times 3$ rectangles, 12 across, 2 rows, 26 inches.
2 (24) $8 \times 3$ rectangles, 12 across, 2
rows, 16 inches.
$13 / 8$ yards for 3 NICU quilts.
